Small, boutique Champagne house producing a superb quality & value Chardonnay dominated Non Vintage blend. Fresh and crisp with apple and lemon fruit, toasty aromas and an elegant creamy finish. | NV | £39.90 |
| 2. | Bollinger Special Cuvee Brut
Bollinger's big, full flavoured house style, using a high proportion of reserve wines, has made this rich and biscuity champagne one of the best known in the world. | NV | £42.90 |

| 6. | Albarino Nai e Senora Rias Baixas
Alluringly fresh: with leafy grassy, floral charm on the nose, lifted by lemon zest. Bolder on the palate with the punch of sherbert lemons and a peachy finish. | 2015 | £12.90 |
| 7. | Pouilly Fumé, Domaine Sébastien Treuillet Loire Valley, France
Classic dry Sauvignon Blanc with gooseberry & grapefruit fruit, smoky flinty notes and a elegant, refined finish. | 2015 | £16.90 |

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| 10. | Rosso Piceno, Saladini Palastrì <i>DOC Marche, Italy</i>
Amazing value wine made from a blend of Montepulciano and Sangiovese. Ripe wild bramble fruit, smoky aromas, chocolate, spice and dried herbs. | 2014 | £ 10.90 |
| 11. | Pinot Noir Touraine Domaine des Chezelles <i>Loire Valley, France</i>
Medium bodied, elegant Pinot Noir dominated by bright red fruit. Lovely fresh strawberry and cherry notes dominate the palate with hints of spice. | 2013 | £11.90 |
| 12. | Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Bohedal <i>Rioja, Spain</i>
Full bodied Crianza with dark red fruit, chocolate, coffee and sweet coconut. The fruit is hot and concentrated but perfectly balanced with fresh minerality. | 2011 | £12.90 |
| 13. | Shiraz, Capel Vale <i>Mount Barker, Australia</i>
From the cooler west of Australia this Shiraz has all the big, dark ripe fruit you would expect along with liquorice, chocolate and caramel notes but there is a fresh violet note that makes the wine twice as attractive. | 2012 | £15.90 |

Louis Roederer Vintage Rose
Refined Rose with red berry fruit and a freshness that is almost unbelievable. | 2014 | £59.00 |
| 15. | Chateau Le Bruilleau , <i>Graves Bordeaux, France</i>
Charming 10 hectares property located south of the city of Bordeaux. The wine is an almost equal blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon, aged 12 months in 25% new oak barrels. It is quite modern and showy with ripe black fruit, toasty vanilla notes and soft tannins but the classic gravelly/graphite notes of the region through. | 2011 | £25.00 |
| 16. | Blason d'Issan <i>Margaux Bordeaux, France</i>
Chateau d'Issan is a beautiful 18th Century Chateau (Complete with moat) that is often cited as one of the most romantic Chateaus in Bordeaux. The vineyards cover 52 hectares & are planted with 70% Cabernet Sauvignon & 30% Merlot. The wines are rich, silky and a little heady in hot vintages but always well textured and elegant. | 2012 | £41.90 |
| 17. | Chateau Pince , <i>Pomerol Bordeaux, France</i>
Chateau Pince is a small 10 hectare estate located at the eastern end of Libourne in the commune of Pomerol. The vineyards sit on dark sand and iron, contain a mixture of 72% Merlot, 23% Cabernet franc and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon. The 2009 is a deliciously soft wine with rich red fruit, damson and classic earthy notes all backed up with some spicy oak notes. | 2010 | £46.50 |
| 18. | Chateau Leoville Barton , <i>St Julien, Bordeaux, France</i>
Leoville Barton produces one of St Julien's best wines. Rich and opulent bouquet of crushed violet and black cherry scents. Medium-bodied with a gentle grip in the mouth. Amazing balance and real quality. | 2006 | £99.00 |
